- 2. Download all the Doodle apps (DoodleMaths, DoodleTables, DoodleEnglish and DoodleSpell) onto an Apple, Android or Amazon device. You can also log in by visiting students.doodlelearning.com/ on a laptop or desktop. Follow the instructions in the video above to log in.
- 3. Use the username and password provided by your child's teacher to log in.

Link your email address to your child's account by visiting parents.doodlelearning.com, hovering over Myaccount and clicking on Child details. Then, press the Link to my child's school account box on the left-hand side of the screen.

Once you've connected your account, you'll then be able to view your child's progress by visiting parents. doodlelearning.com or downloading the free DoodleConnect app on Apple and Android devices.
