Create a boat to sail down the river.	Make a rock pool model inside a plastic bowl. Can you create some sea creatures to go inside too?	Research facts about the sun, its dangers and ways to protect yourself to make an information leaflet.	Visit the library and borrow a book about our sun, sea and sand topic.
Create a fact file about a sea creature of your choice.	Research the problems with plastic pollution in our oceans to create a persuasive poster.	Go on a walk and make a list of the human and physical features you see. <a href="#">What are human and physical features in geography? - BBC Bitesize</a>	Visit the seaside and take some photographs to share with the class.
Create a map of your local area.	Research how seaside holidays have changed since the Victorian times.	Have a 'beach day' in your garden. Take photographs or write a recount to share with the class.	Choose a country to research. Create a PowerPoint presentation all about it.
