We are looking forward to our Summer Disco this evening (July 8). Fingers crossed, this event will take place outside in the courtyard.

#### Lower School Disco for FS2, Year 1 and Year 2.

This is straight after school from 3.15pm to 4.15pm. The children should bring in a bag with their disco clothes in the morning and they will get changed at the end of the school day. Please collect the children from the courtyard in the usual way.

#### Upper School Disco for Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6.

This is from 4.30pm to 5.30pm. The children will go home after school and come back at 4.30pm, dressed in their disco clothes. Please come to the courtyard via the steps as the playground gate will be closed for safety reasons. As the evenings are much

If your Year 5/6 child is walking on their own, they can bring their mobile phone (if they have one), but these must all be handed in to the staff team on arrival. If the staff team see a child with their phone during the disco, the phone will be kept by the staff team and will need to be collected by a parent/carer, not the child.
