Non-negotiable targets for Year 3

Mathematics

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3x, 4x and 8 x table
- Know the value of each digit in 3-digit numbers
- Calculate 100 more and 100 less of a given number
- Multiply numbers by 10, e.g. 25 x 10 = 250
- Add and subtract 3-digit numbers
- Multiply 2-digit number by 1 digit-numbers
- Use remainders in division
- Count in steps of 3, 4, 50 and 100 from zero forwards & backwards
- Count forwards and backwards in tenths
- Apply skills learnt to solve relevant real-life problems in context

Literacy

- Use a range of conjunctions: and, but, because, so, while, if
- Use some time connectives in their writing
- Uses a range of sentence openers
- Past and present tense is used consistently
- Use a range of vocabulary including adjectives, powerful verbs and specific nouns to add impact to their writing
- Common grammatical errors relating to the use of Standard English: e.g. 'they were' not 'they was' and 'we were' not 'we was
- Accurately spell the high frequency words
- Write compositions longer than half a page during independent writing sessions
- Handwriting should be joined
- Consistently use capital letters and full stops
- Accurate use of commas in lists
- Accurate use of exclamation marks and question marks
- Punctuate spoken language using inverted commas
- Use commas to mark clauses
- Use the apostrophe for omission and possession
