Dear Parents and Carers.


We are excited to introduce a brand-new reading initiative across our school — our Class Reading Floor Books!

Each class now has a large Reading Floor Book that will travel home every weekend (Starting Friday 14th November), with one child. Inside, the children will design and create their own special page all about a book they love or are currently reading.

This is a wonderful opportunity for children to celebrate their love of reading, express themselves creatively, and inspire their classmates.

How it Works:

- Every Friday, one child will be chosen to take their class Reading Floor Book home.
- Over the weekend, they will design and decorate their page using the equipment provided in the Reading Floor Book pencil case.
- Their page can include:
 - The book title and author
 - A short summary (without spoilers!)
 - Their favourite part or character
 - How the book made them feel
 - Drawings, quotes, or decorations
 - Who they would recommend the book to



On the next Wednesday, the child will bring the book back to school and share their page with the class.
