Below are some activities you can choose to complete to support your child's learning at home.

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| Find out about how toys have changed over time. You could create a timeline. | Read a book and write a review. What was your favourite part? Who was your favourite character? | Find out about our artist this term - Charles Bell. Can you draw your own version of your favourite piece of his artwork? | Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. |
| Design and label your own superhero. | Log on to Doodle Learning and earn stars! | Can you design a new toy for others to play with? | Create a comic strip about a superhero of your choice. |
| Practise subtracting 2-digit numbers Eg. $45 - 22 =$ You could draw tens and ones to help. | Practise adding 2-digit numbers eg. $23 + 42 =$ You could draw tens and ones to help. | Write 3 sentences that include adjectives to describe a character or setting from a story you've read. | Find out about something old you have at home and what it was used for. Bring it into school to present to the class! |
| Find out about how the way we cook, clean and wash has changed over time. | Learn more about an animal of your choice and its habitat. You could create a fact file or poster. | Make a model of an animal in its habitat using craft materials. | Find out about how our televisions, telephones and music players have changed over time. |
