Year 2- Lincoln castle trip - Tuesday 13th October 2026

Dear Parents / Carers,

As part of our 'Castles and Dragons' topic, we have arranged a very exciting trip to enhance the children's learning. On **Tuesday 13th October 2026** we will be visiting Lincoln Castle for a Medieval Day! The day will include a castle tour and wall walk, shield making, knight and archer training, and also experiencing a Medieval banquet.

In order to make the most of the day we have booked a bus to depart from school at 9.00am. Please can we ask that your child arrives at school on time to give us enough time to do registration and go to the toilet before setting off. We are aiming to return to school by the end of the day but please be aware that we may be slightly late if there is traffic. We hope to return no later than 3.15pm

As you are aware the cost of living has increased dramatically recently and as mentioned in previous newsletters the cost of trips, especially transportation has also increased. We are going to do some fundraising to bring the cost of this trip down as much as we can.

The cost of this trip will be **£20.00 per child. Or £15.00 if you are in receipt of Pupil premium, which will be available for you to pay via your Arbor app.**

Please be aware that we will only be organising one more trip with this kind of cost this academic year.

Children must wear school uniform on the day. Please make sure your child is wearing suitable footwear that they are able to walk around comfortably in. In case of any rain your child also needs to wear/bring a waterproof coat or jacket, preferably one with a hood.

It will be much easier for the children if they bring everything they need for the day in one rucksack style bag. They will need lunch and also drinks for the day. If you would like your child to have a school packed lunch please indicate on the online form. If you have asked school to provide their lunch then they still need to bring a suitable bag to school to then put their lunch in.

We are looking for some parent helpers to accompany us on this trip. If you are able to help on this visit please indicate on the online form. There is no charge for parent helpers. We will let you know if we require your help ASAP.

We are really looking forward to the trip and we know the children are very excited! If you have any other questions about the trip then please don't hesitate to ask.
